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CLINICAL ACNE TREATMENT CONSENT

Clinical acne treatments are corrective procedures. We generally treat the face, neck and back of those affected by skin disorders such as: acne, clogged pores, blackheads, razor bumps and dead skin build up, etc.

The clinical acne treatment usually consists of cleaning, enzyme exfoliation (enzymes dissolve the dead skin cells and soften debris in the pore), extractions with sterile instruments, tonic rinsing, a calming medicated mask, and the application of a hydrating anti-inflammatory lotion. At the conclusion of an acne treatment, liquid nitrogen may be applied to penetrate deeper into the skin to destroy more bacteria that cause acne.

Full clinical acne treatments take approximately 45 minutes to one hour and are designed to cleanse and exfoliate as much as possible in the allotted time. Superior results are achieved when a regimen scheduled by your healthcare provider is followed in the office and at home. Clinical acne treatments should be performed as directed, usually once every 4 weeks for optimal skin maintenance.

The nurse or clinical para medical esthetician will be wearing surgical gloves throughout the entire procedure. Instruments used during the procedure are either disposable or sterilized. The treatment room and equipment are sanitized after every treatment. Clinical acne treatments are safe (with doctor's approval) for pregnant and lactating women.

Conclusion: we are mainly dedicated to helping you improve your complexion problem dramatically. This is a medical treatment not a facial. From time to time you may hear background noise and at times the nurse/estheticians may need to leave your side. At times you may have one or more nurses/estheticians working with you. This is normal and should be expected.
